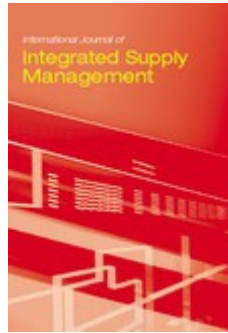

The special issue invites significant and original scholarly research papers in the area of interdisciplinary supply chain management that would be of value to the academic and practitioner supply chain management community.

The special issue will publish scholarly empirical and theoretical high-impact research articles on interdisciplinary supply chain Management issues. Studies will relate to and report significant developments in supply chain management practices drawn from business/commerce, the public and private sector, and non-profit organisations, from both macro and micro perspectives.

The special issue will consider theoretical and empirical papers, including case studies that add new knowledge to different domain areas of supply chain management and related disciplines. Methods can include soft computing techniques, multi-criteria decision making applications, quantitative techniques and modelling, as well as qualitative analytical techniques.

The Guest Editors will be inviting substantially extended versions of selected papers presented at the [Research Conference on Operations & Supply Chain Management \(RCOSCM 2019-20\)](#) for review and potential publication, but are also inviting other experts to submit articles for this call.

Subject Coverage

Suitable topics include, but are not limited, to the following:

- Information technology in supply chain management
- Role of human factors in the supply chain
- Effect of supply chain management on finance and economics, marketing channels, and service management
- The strategic importance of operations in supply chain management
- Effective organizational change management in the context of supply chain management.

Notes for Prospective Authors

Submitted papers should not have been previously published nor be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. (N.B. Conference papers may only be submitted if the paper has been completely re-written and if appropriate written permissions have been obtained from any copyright holders of the original paper).

All papers are refereed through a peer review process.
